Iford Sunday Drop In for the homeless was set up over 30 years ago by members of our diocese. We feed about 35- 40 homeless or vulnerably housed people weekly with a hot meal, drink and sandwiches in St Peter & St Paul's Parish Centre. Since the pandemic we have only served takeaway meals but from Christmas onwards we would like to resume a sit down service as our guests miss the social interaction and respite from the cold weather. We need to recruit more volunteers for this to happen. Volunteers are placed on a rota once a month or more often if they wish. They are needed between 12 to 3 pm to help set up, serve customers, clear away and chat to our guests.
