Interested in Becoming a Catholic? Each year, we run a course from September until after Easter for adults who have not been baptised, as well as for Christians of other denominations who would like to be received into the Roman Catholic Church, and Roman Catholics who have not been confirmed. If you use this method, please put your **Surname and First name** as a reference. If you are part of the Gift Aid scheme, then please also add your **Gift Aid number**. So a typical reference might be: **“Gift Aid number - Surname and First name”**

Please note that setting up monthly standing order is preferable instead of weekly, in order to reduce the administrative burden.

By entering this reference we will be able to make sure that your generosity is increased in line with the Gift Aid regulations. If you are a taxpayer, we would also be grateful if you would Gift Aid your offering. Further information and forms are available on the parish website under the heading Parish Finance and from the church porch.
